Any person who provides a "cloud computing service" (defined) to an educational institution is prohibited from using that service to "process" "student data" (both defined) for any secondary uses that benefit the service provider or any third party. **First Sponsor:** Rep. HM 2003 TECH CORRECTION; URGING THE PRESIDENT

The House of Representatives urges the President of the U.S. to take unspecified action (blank in original). Apparent striker bus. **First Sponsor:** Rep. Tobin **ARS Titles Affected:** 99

S 1484 TAX CREDIT; MANUFACTURERS; RENEWABLE ENERGY

Establishes an individual and corporate income tax credit for investments of at least \$300 million in a three-year period in new "renewable energy facilities" (defined) in Arizona that produce energy for self-consumption using using renewable energy resources if the power will be used primarily for manufacturing. The credit is \$1 million per year for five years for each renewable energy facility, and the maximum credit allowed per taxpayer per year is \$5 million. A

credit may not be claimed for any tax year after 2025. Establishes requirements for taxpayers and facilities to qualify for the credit. Co-owners of a business are authorized to each claim the pro rata share of the credit based on ownership interest. If the credit exceeds taxes due, the amount of the claim not used may be carried forward for up to five consecutive tax years. **First Sponsor:** Sen. Worsley **Other Sponsors:** Sen. McComish, Sen. SCM 1009 MEDICARE ENROLLMENT REQ; PHYSICIANS; REPEAL

The Legislature urges the U.S. Congress to repeal the requirement that physicians who have a National Provider Identifier enroll in or opt out of Medicare as a condition for payment of claims for ordered or provided covered services under federal health care programs. The Secretary of State is directed to transmit copies of this memorial to the President of the U.S., the President of the U.S. Senate, the Speaker of the U.S. House and each member of Congress from Arizona. **First Sponsor:** Sen.
